Exhibited at Singapore's Ikkon Art Gallery, the works by media artist Naoko Tosa allude to the fading of old customs and the beckoning of a new future. In homage to the art of Rimpa, one of the major historical schools of Japanese painting from 17th-century Kyoto, the pieces are an evocative portrayal of flowers fragmented by natural elements such as wind and thunder.

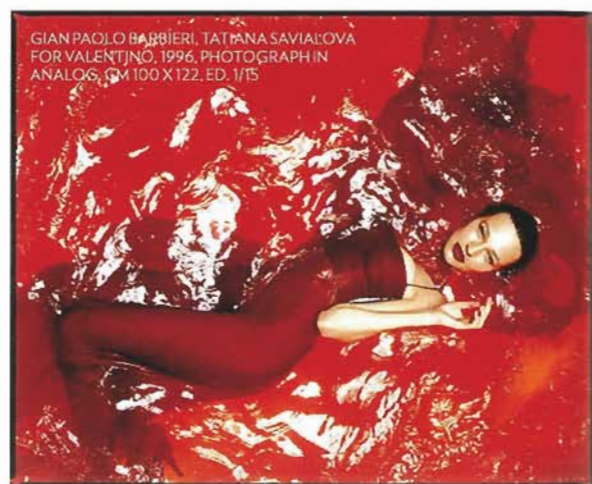
CULTURE CHANEL

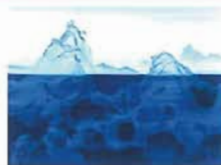
